WHAT ARE LABA CHILDREN'S CAMPS?

LABA stands for creative day camps in Vienna for adventurous and inquisitive children aged 4,5 to 10.

*during the summer, fall, semester and Easter vacations

We teach children about art and culture in a playful way. This mixture of "learning through play" and "playing with knowledge" runs like a red thread through our program. We want the children to relax, have a great vacation experience and have fun. The vacation camp should be a community experience in which contacts are made and friendships forged..

Our practical work is characterized by a wide variety of artistic means of expression combined with a well thought-out range of high-quality and stimulating materials, including: Clay, paper, natural and recycled materials, light, shadow, colors and sounds. We place the highest value on as much practical activity as possible combined with a high proportion of movement and play activities both within our camp facilities and on numerous trips and excursions.

PEDAGOGICAL CONCEPT

For us, it is also very important to create an atmosphere of constant exchange and thus the independent learning of creative and social skills. Many individual ideas and contributions result in creative cooperation. This promotes social skills enormously.

Our educational program is inspired by the philosophy and methods of Reggio pedagogy. The ideas and principles of this educational philosophy were developed after the war in the northern Italian town of Reggio-Emilia and were shaped by Loris Malaguzzi, the director of the town's kindergartens. It offers children the opportunity to develop their individual abilities to the full and aims to sensitize them to discover the secrets and magic of their everyday environment.

ORGANIZATIONAL ASPECTS

Children between the ages of 4.5 and 10 can take part.

A program unit runs over the course of a week from Monday to Friday, from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm. Please bring slippers, weatherproof clothing for when you are out and about, a water bottle and a small snack.

BERGGASSE 13 IN THE HEART OF THE SERVITENVIERTEL - OUR SPACE

We set up our "base camp" in a spacious studio in the heart of Vienna's 9th district, at Berggasse 13/3. From the U2 station Schottentor, exit Hohenstaufengasse/Lichtensteinstrasse it is only a 5 minute walk to us.

The spacious premises previously housed exhibitions of the Sigmund Freud Museum and have been lovingly restored by us. On an area of almost 150 m² with high rooms, lots of light and even more character, we give free rein to our creativity. We start our excursions from here and come back again. We only use the Vienna public transport system or our feet for our excursions.

The Innere Stadt, University of Vienna, Wiener Ring and numerous parks, stores, restaurants and cinemas are in the immediate vicinity.

The following lines stop (almost) on the doorstep: D, 1, 2, 37, 38, 40, 40A, 41, 42, 43, 44, 71.
